

DRUGS WILL NEVER REPLACE LIQUOR, SAYS LONDON PHYSICIAN

Dr. D. H. Arnott Denies Existence of "Govt. Figures" of Increase During O. T. A.

There is room for honest difference of opinion as to the need for continued enforcement of the Ontario Temperance act, but statements compiled and put out with the intention of deceiving the voters should not pass unchallenged.

Dr. Arnott, who has been in London since 1915, has been treated successfully in both hospitals in London, and he knows there are fewer looking for help now than was formerly the case.

Drug addiction is practiced in private by the sufferer, while sociality characterizes drinking to excess. The two addictions are so entirely different that drugs never have and never will supplant or replace liquor.

No increase since O. T. A. In spite of statements to the contrary, we know there has been no increase in the normal number of drug addicts since the inception of the Ontario Temperance act. The only class in which there has been an increase is that of soldiers, who have received terrible wounds, needed prolonged use of narcotics to relieve their pain. Some of these have become addicted to drug addiction, but aside from that there have been fewer new drug addicts since 1915 than there were before the Ontario Temperance act came into force.

Denies Existence of Figures. To prove his statement on this point the Citizen's Liberty League quote what are said to be Government figures purporting to show an enormous increase in drug consumption in Canada since 1916. There are no government figures available which can show any increase in the consumption of drugs in Canada during that period.

There has been an increase in the amount of narcotic drugs handled by the trade since 1916, but this increase in the trade was not consumed in Canada, and the high officers of the Citizens' Liberty League know it.

Drugs Here for U.S. Prior to the passage of the Ontario Temperance act here, there was enacted in the United States the Harrison law, covering the whole of that country. It forbids the sale of narcotic drugs to addicts or others except upon the presentation of special order blanks issued by the government. These must be signed by a physician and each is numbered and traced. Narcotics are sold, but physicians as well, are required to show where every dose of narcotic goes. We have no such strict

VOTERS FAVOR THREE BYLAWS AT WINGHAM

WINGHAM, Oct. 17.—Three bylaws voted on here today carried. On the bylaw to install hydro-electricity 220 voted in favor, and 13 against. For the bylaw to provide \$40,000 toward bringing power from Niagara Falls 236 voted in favor and 18 against.

The bylaw to provide a bonus for the Aero-Cushion Fire Company, 270 favorable votes were cast and 53 opposed.
