BIG CROWD LISTEN TO JUNCTION LIQUOR CASES

Magistrate Gives Some Fatherly Advice—Funeral of John Burke—County Notes.

TORONTO JUNCTION, March 23.—Joseph Maheaux, proprietor of the Occidental Hotel, for selling liquor without a license, \$50 and costs, and for keeping liquor without a license \$25 and costs.

Fred Strange of the Peacock Hotel, for sending liquor without a license, \$50 and costs, and for keeping liquor without a license \$30 and costs.

Robert Fennell, proprietor of a boarding-house at 104 Mapple-avenue, for selling liquor without a license, \$60 and costs, and for keeping liquor without a license \$25 and costs.

These sentences were handed out by Police Magistrate Ellis in the police court this afternoon against three of the five hotelkeepers whose premises were raided on Friday by the local police and provincial police.

The trial of against Harry Vanzyle, proprietor of the Alhambra Quick Lunch on Dundas-street, and Alexander Nelson of the Subway Hotel were adjourned for eight days. Vanzyle pleaded not guilty to three charges and asked for an adjournment, as he wanted to get some witnesses from New York.

Nelson is at present suffering from a broken arm and shoulder, and a doctor's certificate was produced to show that he was unable to appear in court. His lawyer pleaded not guilty and secured an adjournment. This is Nelson's second offence, he being fined on a former occasion, when he kept the Peacock Hotel.

Great Interest Was Shown.

The police court was certainly the town's centre of attraction to-day. The room was jammed to the doors, and the outside steps were crowded by interested spectators who stood along the street and held up their hands to show what was going on within. The prosecution was conducted by Assistant County Crown Attorney Monahan.

Many Cases Adjourned.

After imposing the fine on Fred Strange, Police Magistrate Ellis offered him a word of warning: "The inspector has a right to search your premises," said Magistrate Ellis. "The next time it will be imprisonment without the option of a fine. If you can't make your business pay without breaking the law, you'd better go out of it." He might be some sympathy for a man whose license had been taken away from him, but in this instance, where you bought the hotel knowing it was in a position there, there is no excuse. A man who breaks the law in order to make money ought to be punished, and he'll be punished so far as I am concerned."

Council Will Be Asked to Take Some Action at Once.

NORWAY, March 23.—(Special)—Residents of Coxwell and Reid-villages north of the Grand Trunk Railway will discuss Monday evening the setting up of a post office, which would be preferred to the existing one at the junction of the two roads.

South of the G.T.R. both of these streets are thickly populated, as far as Queen-street west, the railway line being placed in good repair, and considerable sidewalk pull down.

Last summer the school trustees of the Norway section, with the consent of the council, subdivided the large northern section into modern up-to-date four-roomed school on Ashdale-avenue, east of Reid-avenue, and south of the tracks, the pupils north of which hitherto had been allowed to cross over at Coxwell-avenue in order to reach the school.

Some 50 families reside between this point and the Ashdale-avenue, and in order to compel the pupils to go along Danforth-avenue westerly to Greenwood or easterly to Woodbine-avenue, and by this circuitous route to the Ashdale school, a distance of some cases of three and a half miles, the same conditions apply to the pupils, many who were on Sunday peregrinations to attend the Norwegian mission.

The danger attending the Coxwell crossing and the right of the company to close it is conceded, but the company are charged with neglect in not making provision to secure a safety way at this point.
