President Lafontaine, in a few well chosen words, thanked the delegates for the uniform kindness and courtesy shown him during his incumbency of the office of President, and concluded by introducing to the Congress the newly-elected President, Geo. T. Beales.

Mr. Beales, on taking his seat, returned thanks for the honor done him in electing him to the position of President.

There being no further business, the Congress adjourned at 7.05 p.m., on Wednesday, to meet in the City of Montreal, on a date to be selected by the Executive Committee.
