It is a common saying with enemies of Canada and of British institutions like the editor of the Globe that the growth of population in Canada is slow and that we will never increase as rapidly as we ought to do until Canada becomes a part of the United States. It has been pointed out many times that the growth of the Maritime Provinces of Canada is far more rapid than that of Maine, New Hampskire and Vermont, the states which lie next to them, yet even this does not silence our detractors who at once put forth the claim that these states do not fairly represent the growth of the country. We propose today to examine the comparative growth in population of Canada and the states nearest to us, a little more closely.

The five States that lie to the south of the flour older provinces of Canada are Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, New York and Pennsylvania. These states embrace more than one fifth of the population and one half of the wealth of the United States. They contain its three largest cities, besides two others containing more than 150,000 inhabitants and five with more than 50,000 people. 


