

MATRICULATION EXAMINERS.

Fee for Examination, \$5. This fee shall not be returned in case of rejection of the candidate. The Preliminary or Matriculation Examination is appointed by the Provincial Medical Board for the first Wednesday in May, third Wednesday in September, and third Wednesday in November.

N. B.—Graduates in Arts of recognized Universities are not required to submit to this examination.

REGULATIONS FOR DEGREE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY.

1st.—No one shall be admitted to the Degree of Doctor of Medicine and Master of Surgery, who shall not have attended Lectures for a period of at least four years, subsequently to the date of passing his Matriculation Examination, in this College or some other University, College, or School of Medicine approved by this College; (a certificate from his tutor or tutors that the applicant has been one year studying Medicine in the office of one or more registered Medical Practitioners will be received in lieu of one of the four years of study—but in any case three years additional study either in this or some other approved school of Medicine will be required.)

2nd.—Candidates for the Final Examination shall furnish Testimonials of attendance on the following branches of Medical Education, viz:
