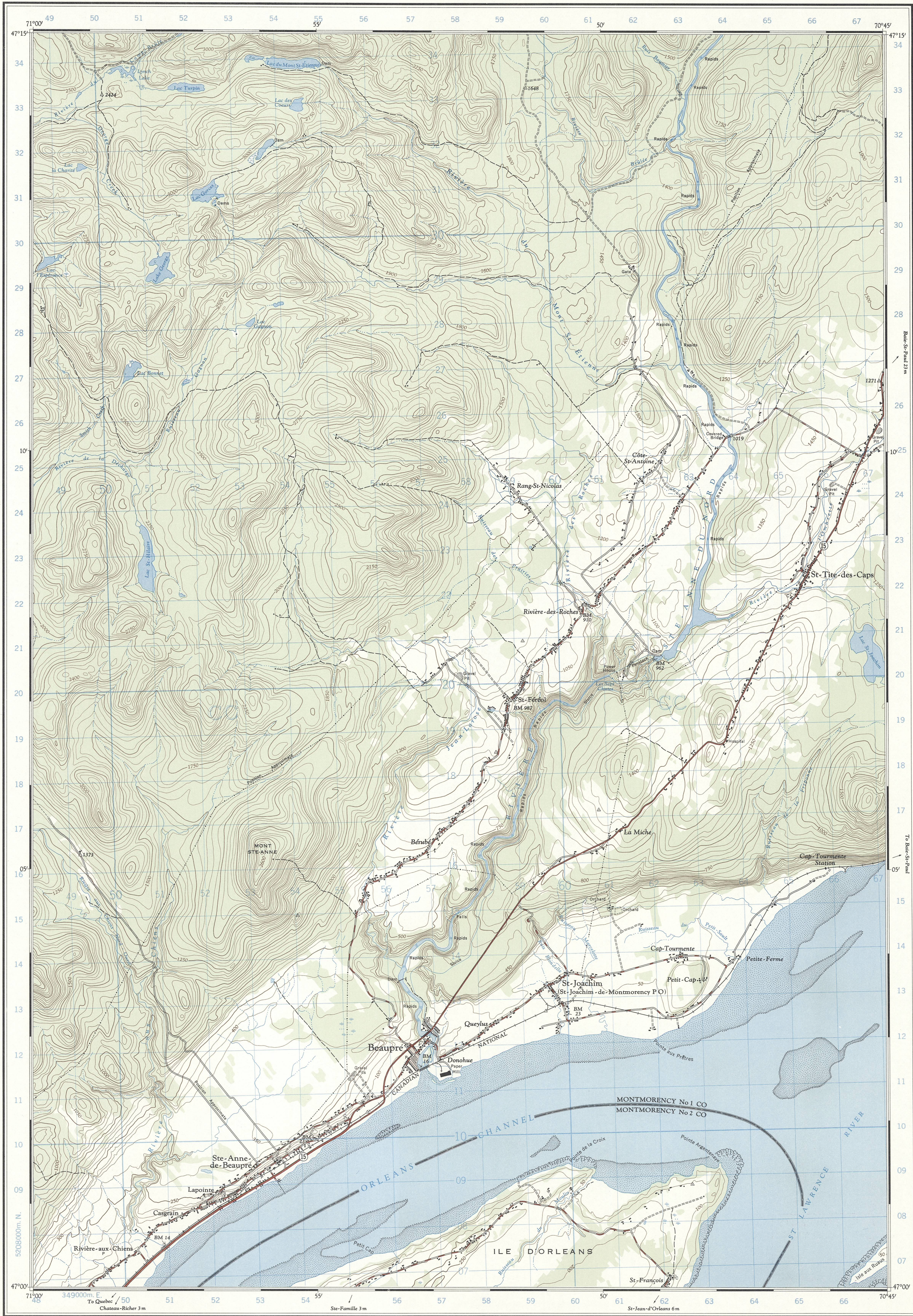
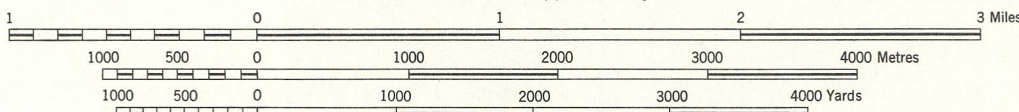

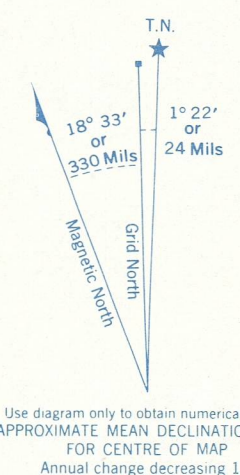

EXAMPLE: SCHOOL

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.	59
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	19
