# ZEPPELINS ADD

Nine Horses Killed, 3 Hurt · Result of the Raiders' Efforts.

SIX MACHINES TOOK PART IN THE FIASCO

German Airmen Took No Chances in Inland Towns -Berlin Report of Raid Typical Piece of German Fiction.

London, Aug. 3—Six German air-ships took part in the raid on the eastern counties of England, this morning, according to an official announcement issued this afternoon, which says eighty bombs are reported to have been dropped. Nine horses were killed and three horses were injured, the statement adds.

The text of the official statement follows:

"Seygral hostile airships attacked.

"Several hostile alrahips attacked the eastern and southeastern councies last night. They first reports were received about midnight. From these, it seems that not less than six airships were attacking the counties of Norfolk, Suffolk and Essex, more or less simultaneously. The raid lasted about an hour and a half.

"Except at one point, the raiders did not penetrate very far inland, but contented themselves with dropping a few bombs at a time on widely distant localities, mainly near the sea. Several bombs, are reported to have fallen into the sea.

"Anti-aircraft guns came into action in one locality, but the raiders there attacked made good their escape.

The Zeppelins were attacked by light British forces, but all returned undamaged, says the statement, which follows:

"During the wint."

"During the night of August 2, a great number of our naval ships again attacked the southeastern counties of England and successfully dropped a great number of explosive and fire to base at Harwich, on railway works, and on, from a military viewpoint, important industrial establishments in the county of Norfolk. On their approach the airships were attacked by enemy light forces under the rays of numerous searchlights, but all returned undamaged."


