CONFERENCE AT MONCTON TO TALK ABOUT HIGHWAYS
Special to The Standard.
Fredericton, N. B., Oct. 16.—Hon. P. J. Young, Minister of Public Works, and the chief highway engineer, H. M. Hill, will represent New Brunswick Friday at a conference to be held in Moncton between our province and the three Maritime Provinces and Federal Highway Commissioners. The Federal Commissioners will be represented by Chairman McGrath and one of his colleagues. It is not known here who will represent the other two provinces. The conference will be upon various matters connected with improved roads and federal assistance.

A new company, to be known as Co-operative Sale and Garage, Limited, is being promoted in Fredericton and vicinity. The new company is to be capitalized in the vicinity of \$25,000 and the co-operative principle will be applied to it. The promoters of the new organization have been negotiating for the wooden building in Westmorland street, formerly used by the John Palmer Company as a factory, and it is understood, will alter it and use it as a garage. The incorporation of the new company is expected at an early date, probably next week.

Robert S. Barker, official secretary to Lieutenant-Governor Pugsley, has received word from his son, Captain Theodore Barker, who is now attached to the Imperial Forces, that he was leaving soon for Egypt, Hong Kong, China or Constantinople. Captain Barker has just completed a course of instruction at Aldershot, and stood well in a class of fifty. He went overseas with the 2nd Battery from this city in February, 1916.
