31.

Unprovided cases.

That in all unprovided cases, resort shall be had to the Rules, Usages and Forms of Parliament, which shall be followed, until this House shall think fit to make a Rule applicable to such unprovided cases.

DIVISION OF THE HOUSE.

32.

Names when to be taken.

That upon a Division in the House, the names of those who vote for, and of those who vote against the question, shall be entered upon the Minutes, if two Members require it.

MOTIONS AND QUESTIONS.

33.

Motion to adjourn.

That a motion to adjourn shall always be in order: Provided that no second motion to the same effect shall be made until after some intermediate proceeding may be had.

34.

Motion that the Chairman leave the chair. That a motion that the Chairman leave the chair, shall always be in order, and shall take place of any other motion.
