

From thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued, from the Expiration thereof, for the further Term of Seven Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.

X. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That an Act made in the Twenty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for the more effectual Encouragement of the Manufactures of Flax and Cotton in *Great Britain*, which was to continue in Force for Two Years, from the First Day of January, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued from the Expiration thereof, for the further Term of Two Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.

Act 23 Geo. III. Cap. 77, continued for 2 Years.

XI. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That so much of an Act, made in the Nineteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, as relates to allowing a Drawback of the Duties on Rum shipped as Stores to be consumed on Board Merchant Ships, on their Voyages, which was to be in Force for Two Years, from the First Day of April, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine; and which, by Two Acts, made in the Twenty-first and Twenty-fourth Years of the Reign of His said Majesty, was further continued until the First Day of April, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-six, shall, from and after the passing of this Act, be revived, and the same is hereby revived, and shall continue in full Force and Effect until the First Day of April, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-eight.

So much of Act 19 Geo. III, Cap. 22, as relates to a Drawback on Rums shipped as Stores for Merchant Ships, revived, and further continued until April 1, 1788.

XII. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for granting a Bounty upon the Importation of Hemp, and rough and undressed Flax, from His Majesty's Colonies in *America*, which was to continue in Force from the Twenty-fourth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and sixty-four,

Act 4 Geo. III, Cap. 26, revived, and further continued until June 24, 1806.
