

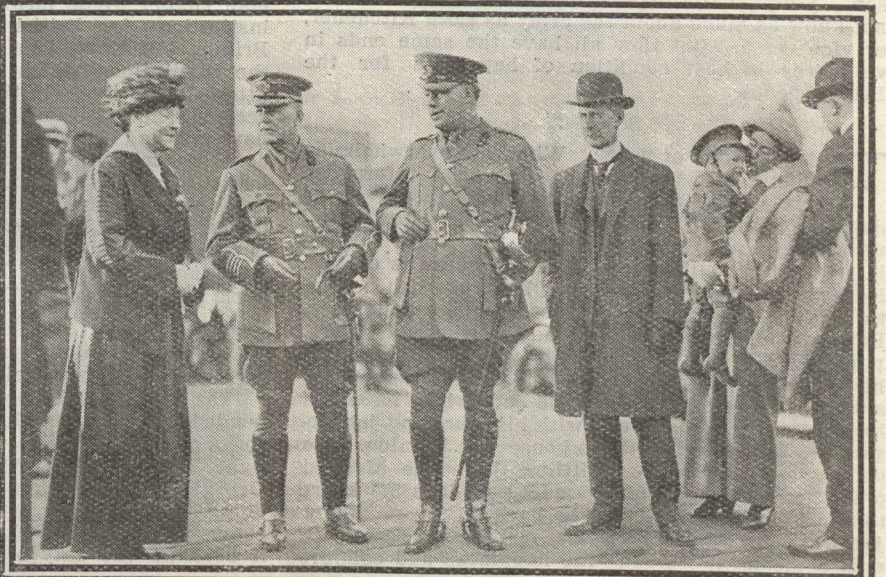
THE COMING AND THE GOING OF ARMED MEN
