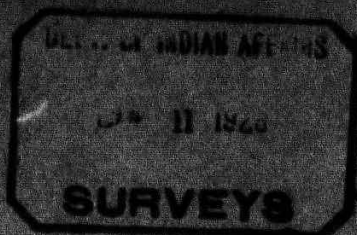

Sir-

I have to make the following report on my progress during the month of June.

On June the 2nd. I left Rupert and proceeded to Warka Channel, where I surveyed the following Reserves. I.R.s. No. 36, 47, 48, 50, 51, 52, 54, 56, 60, 61 and 31.

I still have Nos. 58, 35, 37, and 53, to survey up Warka Channel.

During the month I arranged through Mr. Cellison Indian Agent for the services of an Indian to show me the location of these reserves. But after taking him out I found that he had very little more idea than I had about these places.

I have been without the services of an Assistant so far but I am expecting Mr. Jones B.C.L.S. to join me on June 6th.
