In Treaty No. 3. R. J. Pithers Agency, Sub. Lac Seul Band, your attention is drawn to this woman who was paid for a family of three, in the margin of the Pay Sheet she is stated to be Cameron wife, If Cameron is a white man or non treaty Indian his children have no right to share the annuity.

The instructions given by you to Mr. Agent McKay and referred to in your letter of the 5th February last were correct, and unless the family is entirely broken up by marriage or death, it should bear the same.
