

accommodation one story and three quarters or two stories high would only require about one half the quantity of roof and one half the extent of foundation, and would add nothing to the cost except a small item for a flight of stairs, besides the arrangements for and expense of heating would be 33% less in a building of two stories than in the one proposed.
