Gentlemen-

In reply to your letter of the 16th Instant requesting a duplicate of account rendered you for dues on timber taken from the Temisamingue Indian Reserve in the Season of 1900-1901, I beg to enclose herewith three statements showing amounts due for trespass on Locations, and on John Wabie's Lot, with costs of seizure, also on timber cut under your License on the Reserve, making a total of \$536.47-

As you have paid the groundrent on that part of the Reserve, where the Indian Locations are situated, containing 2200 acres, equal to 3-7/16 square miles, since the License was issued, you are entitled to a refund of \$72.17, which leaves the balance now due \$464.30, with interest thereon from the first of December last.

The ground-rent and renewal fee payable for renewal of License to the 30th April 1903 is \$171.69
