
With cheque.

Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th ultimo enclosing vouchers Nos. 1584, 1585, and 1586 amounting in all to \$387.60 for 175 sacks of flour and freighting same, and in reply I beg to inform that cheque No. 3077 for \$315.00 (amount of voucher 1584) has been sent to the Lake of the Woods Milling Co; cheque No. 3078 for \$2.60 has been forwarded to you in payment of voucher No. 1585, and I enclose herewith cheque No. 3079 for \$70.00 in your favor in payment of voucher No. 1586 in order that you may pay the Indians who did the freighting.

Kindly obtain the Indians' receipts in duplicate, one set of which you should forward with your cash-book return. The cheque number should be written on the receipts, also on the cash-book return opposite the amount of the cheques
