Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo in which you state that you omitted to mark or have marked all the posts in the sub-division you made of The Pas Townplot and in which you request authority to send an assistant whom you have engaged, to do this work. The Department supposed that you had completed jour survey at The Pas but on account of the ground being frozen it was necessary to re-drive the posts this spring; this would have been a very simple matter but as you state the markings require checking, etc., a surveyor whom the Department has engaged for other work but who will necessarily be at The Pas for a day or two will be instructed to do this work.
