
Rev. Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 4th instant I beg to inform you that the full grant has been paid to the Brandon Industrial school for pupils Nos. 0152, 0153 and 0153 for the September quarter last.

The grant is also paid for Elizabeth and Ellen Fisher from the date on which they are shown by the return to have entered the school, viz., August 24th, 1912. You should have these two girls examined by a doctor and forward their application for admission and certificate of health as soon as possible.

With reference to Elizabeth Cook, the grant has not been paid for her pending further information as to her status as an Indian. Her application will be placed before Mr Inspector Bunn, who will be asked to report on this case. Should his report be favourable the grant will then be paid for this girl from the date on which she entered the school.
