Referring to your letter of the 4th Instant, regarding return of rental paid under Lease No 81, I beg to say that before this is done, it will be necessary for the Department to be in possession of a full report in the matter.

In letter of the 27th Ultimo, you make requisition for Cheques in favour of Mrs. Jessie Morrison, Jean Elizabeth McDougall and John T. McDougall, but the Department must be assured that the first mentioned is married to an Indian of the Band, also the daughter and name of the latter's husband, as it is hardly possible that her name is McDougall, although you give it as such.

If it is proved to the satisfaction of the Department that the three persons mentioned in your letter are entitled to share in the money referred to, separate cheques will be prepared and forwarded to you in the usual way.
