Re: Timber - Ahousaht Band

In reply to your letter of November 8/52, file 20-7-1-19 (159) enclosed is original resolution from the Ahousaht Band agreeing to the 1/3 - 2/3 distribution of funds received from their timber operation, with the Advance Logging Co. Also enclosed is original agreement between this Band and the Advance Logging Co. I have had difficulty in obtaining this agreement as Mr. Knott has had it in his possession since January.

It will be noted that Reserve No. 17 has been struck off and his operation will be on Reserves, 18, 19 and 20 only. A cheque for \$6,000.00 as a security deposit has been received and is being forwarded to the Receiver General. Would you kindly advise if I may approve this agreement.
