Dollars, be paid out of money standing
to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of Timber permits
be issued to three members of Squamish Band to each cut
for sale from Squamish I.R. No. /4 200,000 f.b.m. Alder,

Maple, and Cottonwood, subject to payment of required dues.
