

Squamish No. 14 (Waiwakum) Indian Reserve,

June 10th, 1948

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Squamish Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Brackendale, in the Vancouver Indian Agency, in the Province of B.C. at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 10th day of June, A.D. 1948, in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, request that a sum not exceeding Dollars, be paid out of money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of - Timber permits be issued to three members of Squamish Band to each cut for sale from Squamish I.R. No. 4 200,000 f.b.m. Alder, Maple, and Cottonwood, subject to payment of required dues.
