against the Force and any other liquidation costs. The Committee adopted without debate a resolution which took note of the revised cost estimates of UNEF for 1967 and outlined the method by which any expenditures relating to UNEF after December 31, 1967, would be met. Approval was also given for additional appropriations both for 1967 and 1968 for the expansion of UNTSO operations, necessitated by the conflict in the Middle East in June 196', and for the creation of the United Nations Middle East Mission (UNMEM).
