- Waschkeffel**, *m.*, -s, —, wash-boiler.
- Waschkleidchen**, *n.*, -s, —, wash dress, summer frock.
- Wasser**, *n.*, -s, —, water.
- Wassermühle**, *f.*, -n, water-mill.
- weben** (webte and wob, gewebt and gewoben), *tr.*, to weave.
- weden**, *tr.*, to waken.
- weder**, *conj.*, neither.
- Weg** (long e), *m.*, -[e]s, -e, way, road; er machte sich auf den Weg nach . . . , he set out for . . .
- weg** (short e), *adv. and sep. pref.*, away.
- weg'gehen** (ging, gegangen), *intr.* (*aux.* *h.*), to go away.
- weg'stoßen** (stieß, gestoßen), *tr.*, to push away, to repel.
- weg'weisend**, *adj.*, showing the way, leading, guiding.
- Weg'weiser**, *m.*, -s, —, leader, guide.
- weh**, *adj.*, sore, aching, painful, sad; wie weh wird mir, how sick at heart I begin to feel.
- Weh**, *n.*, -[e]s, woe, pain, grief; Weh und Ach, lamentations and groans,
- wehen**, *intr.*, to blow, wave; as *subst.*, blowing, waving, fluttering.
- wehmütig**, *adj.*, sad, melancholy; mir wird jetzt noch wehmütig, even now I become melancholy.
- wehren**, *refl.*, to defend oneself, resist.
- Weib**, *n.*, -[e]s, -er, woman, wife.
- weichen** (wich, gewichen), *intr.* (*aux.* *h.*), to yield, vanish.
- Weide**, *f.*, -n, pasture; willow.
- weiden**, *tr. and intr.*, to graze.
- Weihnachten**, *pl.*, Christmas.
- weil**, *conj.*, because.
- Weile**, *f.*, -n, a while, space (of time); eine ganze Weile, a considerable time.
- Wein**, *m.*, -[e]s, -e, wine.
- weinen**, *intr.*, to weep, cry.
- Weise**, *f.*, -n, manner, way.
- Weisheit**, *f.*, wisdom, learning; an Weisheit schwer, rich in learning or wisdom.
- weiß**, *weiss*, see wissen.
- weiß**, *adj.*, white; as *subst.*, mit etwas zierlichem Weissen, with some dainty white (thing).
- weissen**, *tr.*, to whitewash.
- weisschäumend**, *ppl. adj.*, foaming white.
- weit**, *adj.*, wide, broad, extensive; *adv.*, far; und alle Herzen wurden weit, all hearts expanded.
- weiter**, *adj.*, further; *adv.*, further, on, along; und so weiter, and so forth (*abbreviated* to *usw.* = etc.); as *sep. pref.*, further, on.
- Wei'terkommen** (*verbal subst.*), *n.*, -s, getting forward, proceeding.
- wei'terziehen** (zog, gezogen), *intr.* (*aux.* *h.*), to move on, to proceed.
