ARTICLES OF CONSTITUTION

ELECTION OF MEMBERS

1. Every candidate for membership shall be proposed by one Ordinary member and seconded by another, by a proposal in writing, to be inserted in the Book of Candidates, stating the candidate's name, place of residence, and addition, profession or calling, which proposal shall be signed by the proposer and seconder. A notice of such nomination, dated and signed by the Secretary, shall, at least one week before the ballot hereinafter mentioned, be put upon the notice board of the Club, containing the name, residence and addition, profession or calling, of said candidate, together with the names of his proposer and seconder, and the day on which the ballot is to take place. The election shall be by ballot of the members qualified to vote. A notice to the effect that the ballot is open is to be put on the board by the Secretary immediately before the ballot opens. The ballot shall be secret, and be held between the hours of 10 a.m. and 9 p.m., on the first Tuesday in each month. Each member voting shall write his name in the Ballot Book pro-
