## **Committee of Public Improvements.**

To the Warden and Council of the County of Elgin in  
Council Assembled.

**GENTLEMEN:**—

The Committee of Public Improvements, beg leave to report: That they would recommend that the sum of Thirty Dollars be granted for the County Line, between the Township of Yarmouth and Westminster, providing the County of Middlesex grant a like amount.

That the sum of Fifty Dollars be granted for the County Line, between the Townships of Southwold and Deleware, providing the County of Middlesex grant a like amount.

That the sum of Three Hundred Dollars be granted for the County Line between the Township of Bayham and Middlesex, providing the County of Norfolk, grant a like amount.

That the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars be granted for the County Line between Aldborough and Orford, the County of Kent having appropriated the said amount. All of which is respectfully submitted.
