Rule 4. The names of Delegates leaving the Convention withfirst Saturday after out permission of the Body before the conclusion of the business ce as shall be agree shall be publicly reported in the Minutes.

Rule 5. No subject shall be discussed without a motion first

Rule 6. No person shall speak oftener than twice on any loard or Boards shanotion unless by permission of the Body.

Rule 7. Motions made and lost shall not be recorded on the Churches, in the Minutes except so ordered at the time.
