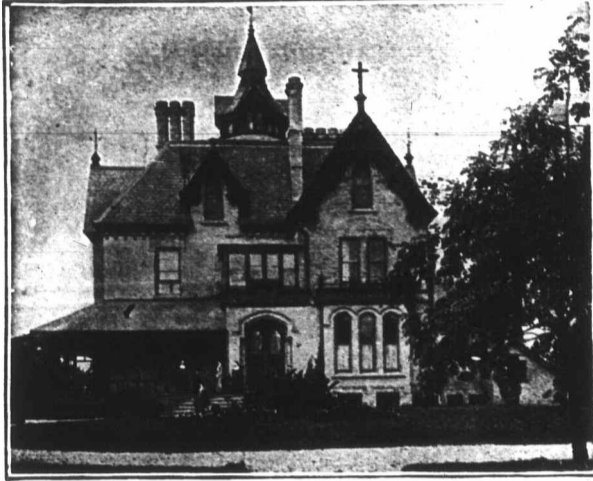

The organ in Hampton Parish Church, which was the gift of King William IV. in 1831, the first organist being Sebastian Wesley, has just been thoroughly restored, and completed by the addition of a pedal 1 ft. reed (trombone). Messrs. Bishop and Son, the firm who built the organ for the King, have done the alterations, and the organ now contains thirty-two speaking stops and 1,842 pipes.
