proper Original Summons or Attachment, and the Writ of Execution, in all Civil Actions, and the Writ of Habere facias Pollellionem, in all Real Actions between Party and Party, shall be in the Form as heretofore have been used and observed.

Ad in order to prevent needles and vexatious Arrests and Imprisonments of H.s Majesty's Subjects, Freeholders and Inhabitants of this Province, for any Sum under Ten Pounds.

Be it enasted by the Authority aforefaid, That no Person or Persons what-soever who now is, are, or hereatter may be a Freeholder and Inhabitant, or Freeholders and Inhabitants in this Province, and whose Freehold is free trom Incumbiances, shall be arrested, imprisoned, or held to Bail, or his or their Goods, Chattels, or Estate attached, unless the Plaintiff in such Action shall make and subscribe an Affidavit in Writing, before a Judge of the Court or the Clerk of the Court, from whence such Writ shall issue, (who is hereby impowered to administer the same) that the Defendant is justly in debted to the Plaintiff in the Sum of Ten Pounds or upwards, according to the present Rate of Currency in Halifax; which Assidavit shall be filed in the Office of the said Clerk, in the Form following, viz.

'In the Court of Common-Pleas, in the "Majesty's Reign.

And if such Action shall be brought by any Agent, Factor, or Attorney, in the Name of his Principal, if absent, upon producing an Affidavit of such Debt, of his Principal, duly authenticated according to the Laws of England, or the Usuage and Practice of the Plantations in such Cases, or if such Principal be in any Part of the Province, remote from the Courts, upon producing an Affidavit taken as aforesaid, before a Justice of the Peace, and upon the said Affidavits being respectively filed as aforesaid, then the said Judge, or Clerk of the said Court, shall direct Bail to be taken in the following Words, viz.

Take Bail for ---- (expressing the Sum in Words at Length), upon Affidavit of the Plaintiss siled according to the Law of this Prov nee. For which Sum, and no more, Bail shall be taken, or the Desendant's Goods, Chattels, or Estates shall be attached.
