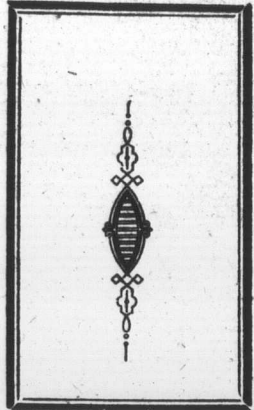

The capital stock of the new company is \$100,000 divided into 1,000 shares of \$100 each.

The provisional directors are Robert Wright, Robert Leslie Wright, George Andrew Wright, Alexander Innis Wright and Wallace Dougal Wright.
