#### Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any man over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency of the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions. By father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

#### DUES—Six months' residence upon and

cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

#### In certain conditions a homesteader in good

standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$2.00 per acre. Dues—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

#### A homesteader who has exhausted the

homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take the same in certain districts. Price \$1.00 per acre. Dues—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
