Liquid Manure.—Prof. Sprengel, the

celebrated German chemist, asserts that

manure annually produces 18,000 pounds

of solid matter 500 pounds

HAY REQUIRED TO KEEP A HORSE.—A

correspondent of the Wisconsin Farmer, who

says that five pounds of hay a feed, or fifteen

pounds per day, with twelve quarts of water

or its equivalent in shorts, will keep a good

horse in fine condition for all road or

farm work, is amply sufficient. Some will

keep considerably less; this however is a

fair average.
