UNDERTAKING BUSINESS.

From an elevation of sufficient height above the Mediterranean and looking seaward over Jerusalem you survey the entire land of Palestine. Far beneath you and washed by the shores of the great sea are distinctly visible the mountains of Tyre, Sidon, Beirut, Joppa and others which directly before you stand the central towers of the Temple, Jerusalem, whose Mosques of Omar, Tower of David Church of the Holy Sepulchre and many of its houses can be plainly seen. Turning to the south you see the country beyond Hebron and even down to Gaza. Bethans and Beulah are before you. To the northeast appears the sea of Galilee where Peter often fished, and on its shores Capernaum, where the Saviour did so many of his mighty works, Chorazin and Bethsaida, so highly favored, Thabes, Magdala and Hippo. Nazareth and even little Cana are not forgotten. On the road to Jerusalem you pass Siches, a city which stood the wall of Jacob on which the weary Messiah as he talked with the women of Samaria, and the very mountain where her fathers worshipped. Near Jordan and commanding the great natural highway leading to the interior of Canaan is seen the noted Jericho of the time of Joshua and down to which from Jerusalem went the road of other important business.
