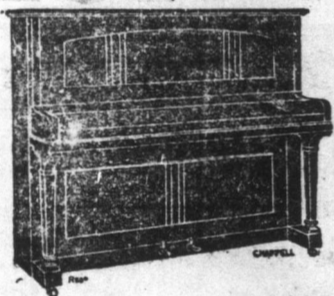

Forty-One Years in the Public Service—The Evening Telegram

Bell Island Cadets.

Official Presentation Championship Cup and other Athletic Trophies Won During the Season.

The Championship Football Cup of Bell Island, won by the Cadets, was officially presented last week to that body at the Star Hall, when over 150 members of "C" Wabana Co. lined up on parade. The occasion was also availed of to present to the Cadet representatives the numerous prizes and trophies they had won during the season at the various Sports, Games and Garden Parties. Judging by the appended Prize List, it was a veritable "Cadet Year" and luck seemed to follow their representatives in most of their efforts. A special Gold Medal was presented by the Corps to Sergt. Matthew Farrell, who was the Victor Ludorum of the Island in the seasons games; he having won twelve medals and being a member of the Championship team, as well as of the Cadet "aves" which won most of the games at the Garden Parties. Following the presentation of prizes, medals for general brigade work and attendance were presented to Sergt-Major J. F. McEvoy, Sergt-Instr. J. Stone, and Sergt-Instr. P. Stoyles. This is the third time that Sergt. Stone has won the medal for general excellence as a brigade member. The presentation was made by Rev. J. J. McGrath, P.P., Chaplain of "C" Co., while Capt. J. M. Greene, O.C. Wabana Co. presided, and the following occupied seats on the platform:—Major Leo C. Murphy, Messrs. W. F. Billingsley, D. J. Jackman, R. D. Walsh, Andrew Murphy, John Connors, J. J. Farrell and D. Steele, while the parade formed up under Lieut. J. J. Murphy. Messages of regret at being unable to attend were read from His Grace the Archbishop, Patron of the Corps, Mr. C. F. Taylor, President of the B. I. Football League, and Dr. Humber A. Giovannetti, J.P. Before the close of the evening Capt. Green, on behalf of the brigade and Football Club, presented Sergt. Frank Jackman with a Gold Watch suitably engraved, as a tribute to the young Sergeant on the eve of his departure for Ireland, where he assumes Ecclesiastical studies.
