For Usefulness Opened to Them.

Canadian Permanent Corps Have a Field For Usefulness Opened to Them.

OTTAWA, March 7.—Major Evans, of Winnipeg, will command a contingent from the permanent corps to be sent to the Yukon as soon as it is outfitted and provisioned.

The government has decided to send this detachment instead of drawing from the Mounted Police of Regina or Edmonton district.

It is probable that from one hundred to two hundred men and officers will be selected from the permanent corps.


