Ald. Fell wished to know if the Mayor wished the legislative committee to make amendments to the Municipal Act to appoint park commissioners...

With regard to the property owners' association, Mayor Morley announced amendments to the association's constitution and he wished to know if they were in the interest of the city.

Ald. Fell moved that the building inspection department be made an examination of the wooden buildings in the block bounded by Fort, Broad, Broughton and Douglas streets.

I desire instructions of the council as to approving or opposing the new sections of the city plan, and I beg to point out the following points of divergence with the existing practice:

(1) Under the present procedure taxes must be two years in default before sale under the new procedure only six months.

(2) Under the present procedure a cent interest is added on arrears under the new procedure 12 per cent. This applies to all arrears.

(3) With regard to notice of intention to sell, under the present procedure all registered owners, mortgages or judgment creditors, have one month's notice before the sale, or substituted service is made as ordered by a judge...

(4) Under the present system only so much of the land is sold as is sufficient to pay the arrears, and the balance is sold at a separate sale...

(5) At present advertisement of a tax sale is made for thirty and to approximately ten days previously, under the new procedure in sections for four weeks and once in ten days for the balance.

(6) Under the present procedure the sale is made by public auction, and the purchaser has the right to obtain a confirmation order to be given to all persons in possession of the land...

(7) Under the present system the collector has introduced this new machinery for tax sale, has left the enabling sub-sections of section 50 in the same form which they have heretofore stood.

Ald. Fullerton called attention to the fact that the appointment of Mr. Dubois as assessor was put on too many committees to do good work, and he thought the members of the board should have been consulted as to the amount of time at their disposal before being appointed to the committees.

Mayor Morley said that it was his intention to hold all the meetings of the council up, and his object was in pointing the streets, sewers and bridges committee was to relieve the council of detail business.

The first business before the meeting was a communication from Hon. R. McBride, who informed the council that in considering the Somers reserve nothing would be done without considering the interests of the city. Received and filed.

Possibilities of The Fruit Industry. Better Grading and Packing Methods Said Will Work A Revolution.

Excerpts from the Evidence of A. McNeill Chief of Division At Ottawa.

The possibilities of an enormous expansion of the fruit growing business of British Columbia with better grading and packing is forcibly brought out in the following excerpts from the evidence of A. McNeill, chief of the Fruit Division, Department of Agriculture...

"Mr. McNeill's evidence should be carefully studied by fruit growers, and there is much practical advice given that should be taken to heart," said J. H. Anderson, Deputy Minister of Agriculture, yesterday. "It is satisfactory to note the credit given by Mr. McNeill to our orchardists, especially with reference to the culture, varieties, packages and grading, in which he emphasizes the fact that we are ahead of our Eastern Canadian competitors in the handling of more orchards the question of car-load shipments will be solved and the fruit of the Northwest prairie province vastly increased."
