At Mazatlan the Georgia encountered a severe storm. The port, where extensive harbor works are contemplated is now open to heavy weather, and the steamer was obliged to put to sea for safety. A number of lighters broke adrift, collided with each other and were wrecked, and some were driven ashore and lost.

The Georgia arrived off Cape Flattery on Sunday night and has since been delayed by the incessant fog. Had it not been for the heavy fog she would have reached port on Monday.
