

## IMPORTS BY FISH SPECIES

The main species are horse mackerel, mackerel and sardinella. These three are the species supplied by Mauretania, the OECD and the COMECON. The other species come partly from Senegal and Mauretania. Recently it has been observed that the size of fish from Senegal is smaller; moreover the quantities of fish from these countries are decreasing, to the benefit of Mauretania.
