THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE CRICKETERS' TOUR BROUGHT CALLED BY BLACK AFRICAN COUNTRIES FOR BRITAIN'S EXCLUSION FROM THE COMMONNEALTH GAMES IN AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND, IN JANUARY..

OF THREATS OF A BOYCOTT IF BRITAIN IS ALLONED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GAMES, RAMPHAL SAID HE HOPES THERE WILL NOT BE ONE.

CLARK SAID HE ALSO IS CONCERNED ABOUT A POSSIBLE BOYCOTT. ""WE'RE WORRIED ABOUT THE THREAT TO A VIABLE AND IMPORTANT COMMONHEALTH INSTITUTION, "" HE SAID.

BUT HE ADDED THAT HE WAS ENCOURAGED BY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S REACTION TO THE CRICKET TOUR! TRYING ""MORAL-SUASION AS THEY HAVE TO BISSUADE SOME OF THEIR ATHLETES.

FOLLOWING THE CONFERENCES CLARK WILL HOLD BILATERIAL TALKS WITH THE AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT THURSDAY BEFORE RETURNING TO CANADA. 42.
