THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS EXCELLENCY MILORAD MILATOVIC PRESENTED TO THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR GENERAL, THE HONOURABLE GERALD FAUTEUX, JUDGE OF THE SUPREME COURT OF CANADA, HIS LETTER OF CREDENCE AS AMBASSADOR EXTRAORDINARY AND PLENIPOTENTIARY OF THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA TO CANADA. THE CEREMONY TOOK PLACE AT THE SUPREME COURT OF CANADA.

THE UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, MR. JULES LEGER, WAS IN ATTENDANCE ON THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR GENERAL. THE CHIEF OF PROTOCOL, MR. J. A. MCCORDICK, PRESENTED THE AMBASSADOR TO THE DEPUTY GOVERNOR GENERAL. THE AMBASSADOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MR. VELJKO VELASEVIC, SECRETARY OF THE EMBASSY. MR. J. F. DELAUTE, SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNOR GENERAL (ADMINISTRATIVE), WAS ALSO PRESENT.

MR. MILATOVIC WAS BORN IN SERBIA IN 1911. HE WAS APPOINTED IN 1953 AS ENVOY EXTRAORDINARY AND MINISTER PLENIPOTENTIARY IN THE SECRETARIAT OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS IN BELGRADE. FROM 1954 TO 1958 HE WAS AMBASSADOR TO POLAND. MR. MILATOVIC IS MARRIED AND HAS THREE CHILDREN.
