Mr. Blake was born in King's Langley, England, on March 7, 1906. He was educated at the University of Saskatchewan from which he received a Bachelor of Science degree in 1934.

Following war service with the Canadian Army, Mr. Blake joined the Department of Trade and Commerce in 1945. He has since served abroad in Washington, London, Melbourne, Port-of-Spain, and Kingston, Jamaica. In 1964, he was appointed Consul General to Hamburg, a position which he held until February of this year.
