Definition of Income

- Workmen's Compensation,
- Canada Pension Plan,
- maintenance allowances under training programs,
- pensions and payments by foreign countries,
- regular or periodic payments from annuities,
- pensions,
- superannuation,
- insurance,
- payments under separation agreements,
- divorce settlements,
- payments under court orders,
- support agreements,
- net wages, salaries and casual earnings,
- gross room or lodging receipts,
- gross board receipts,
- gross rental receipts for self contained quarters,
- payment received on mortgages,
- agreements for sale,
- loans,
- net farm income.

Exemptions

- casual gifts of small value,
- cost of expenses incurred in earning any wages, salary or casual earnings,
- 40 per cent of room receipts, (provided income not reduced below \$10 per roomer per month),
- 60 per cent of board receipts,
- 40 per cent of rental income for self contained quarters.
