The Standing Committee on Standing Orders beg leave to make their second Report, as follows:—

The Committee have examined the following petitions and find that the requirements of the Rules of the Senate have been complied with in all material respects, namely:—

Of The Montreal and Atlantic Railway Company; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing an increase in the limit of its bonding powers.

Of La Corporation Du Pont Du Lac St. Louis; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing it to construct a bridge connecting the north and south shores of the St. Lawrence river opposite the Caughnawaga Indian Reserve, on Lake St. Louis, in the province of Quebec.

Of The Kettle Valley Railway Company; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing the construction of a line of railway from a point at or near Skaha to a point at or near Okanagan Falls, all in the province of British Columbia.

Of The Canadian Pacific Railway Company; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing the construction of a line of railway from a point on its railway between Bresley Station and its terminus at Place Viger in Montreal, to a connection with the company's railway at or near L'Epiphanie, all in the province of Quebec; and extending the time within which it may commence and complete the construction of certain of its authorized lines of railway.
