

having been inspected by the President, it shall then be inspected by the Vice President, who shall announce the state of the ballot, and the result shall be declared by the President to the lodge.

MEETINGS.

6. This Lodge shall hold its regular meetings every _____ evening at 8 o'clock.

The President may summon a special when requested to do so by seven members in good standing ; provided that not less than seven hours notice of the time and object of such meeting be given by the Secretary, by means of a written or printed circular to every member of the Lodge residing in the City.

7. Seven members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any regular or special meeting.

8. No business other than that for which such meeting may be specially called shall be discussed at any such meeting.

OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES.

9. The officers of this Lodge shall be those ordered by the constitution, all of whom shall be elected at the last regular meeting in June and December.

10. Before proceeding to election of officers the President shall appoint three members as scrutineers whose duty it shall be to count the votes and to make a return thereof to the President who shall announce it to the Lodge.

11. It shall be the duty of the Lodge to provide for the support of its members in the event of their becoming destitute or otherwise in need of assistance; and it shall have power to make such provision as may seem best for the purpose.

12. The Lodge shall have power to receive and hold real and personal estate, and to dispose thereof as may seem best for the purposes of the Society.

13. The Lodge shall have power to borrow money, and to mortgage its real and personal estate, and to give security for the same.

14. The Lodge shall have power to sue and be sued, and to take legal proceedings in its own name.

15. The Lodge shall have power to do all such other things as may be necessary or expedient for the carrying out of the objects of the Society.

12. It shall be the duty of the President to assist in the selection of candidates for the initiation of new members and to perform such other duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

13. It shall be the duty of the accurate recorder to keep careful and other proper records and deliver the same to the informant, all of which shall be done when the pro-
