deserving God's wrath and condemnation, let us repent and act lovingly to all men, especially to those who are our brothers in the fight against the devil.

This is Christ's way.

I would suggest that each clergy-man and member of the Church of England make a resolve to pray definitely at least once a week—Thursday being preferred—the prayer of our dear Lord and Master that we all may be one, with a special reference to our union with our separated Protestant brethren.

Let us earnestly strive to promote all things that make for peace, by trying to be lowly, and humble-minded and more concerned with our own sins and short-comings than with our brothers. Let us covet persistently the blessed possession of love which the Holy Ghost will shed abroad in our hearts as we yield ourselves unfeignedly to Him, and the more we love one another the more speedily will we be unified in Christ.
