**Question No. 292—Mr. Cossitt:**

1. What are the names and job designations of all persons concerned with granting funds to the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews in connection with the programme "Open House Canada"?

2. (a) What are the names of the persons signing contracts pertaining to the Programme on behalf of the (i) government (ii) Canadian Council of Christians and Jews (b) what are all the details of any such contracts?

3. To the knowledge of the government, how many written inquiries were received by the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews from the public in connection with the Programme?

4. Has the government received any written inquiries from the public in regard to the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews in connection with the Programme?

**Hon. John Roberts (Secretary of State):** 1. The people concerned with granting funds to the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews in connection with the Open House Canada Program are:

The head, project support and planning, Open House Canada

The chief, social communications

The director, citizens' participation

The associate director, citizens' participation

The assistant under secretary of state, citizenship and bilingualism development

The assistant under secretary of state, cultural affairs

The senior assistant under secretary of state

These officials are involved at various stages of the grants consideration process; approval of grants rests with the Secretary of State.

2. (a) (i) One contract was signed with the CCCJ during the fiscal year 1977-78 under the Open House Canada program for the provision of field support services. The senior assistant under secretary of state signed this contract on behalf of Her Majesty after approval had been given by the Secretary of State.

(ii) The president, signed on behalf of the council.
