

CHAPTER II.

OF THE TIMES OF MEETING.

THIS Lodge shall meet on the second Tuesday of every month, at seven o'clock P.M. from the autumnal to the vernal equinox; and at eight o'clock P.M. from the vernal to the autumnal equinox; and shall continue at work so long as the Master shall think proper.

CHAPTER III.

OFFICERS.

THE Officers of this Lodge shall consist of a master, two wardens, two deacons, an inner guard, and a tyler or tylers; and, if expedient, a chaplain, treasurer, secretary, two or more stewards, and a director of ceremonies.

CHAPTER IV.

OF THE ELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS.

THIS Lodge shall annually elect, by ballot, the master, treasurer, and tyler or tylers, at the regular meeting immediately preceding the festival of St. John, the Evangelist; and, on the morning of that festival, the master, and other newly elected officers, shall be installed according to ancient usage; after which, the master shall appoint and install his wardens and other officers.

CHAPTER V.

OF THE TREASURER'S DUTY.

THE Treasurer shall receive the monies of the Lodge, and discharge bills when duly vouched and
