

RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR THE
LIBRARY AND READING-ROOM
OF THE
Toronto Mechanics' Institute.

SECTION I.

The Library shall be open every day (Sundays and public holidays excepted) from nine o'clock a. m., to ten o'clock p. m., for the delivery and exchange of Books.

SECTION II.

Members and Subscribers, upon application to the Librarian, may obtain books from the Library and retain them for the time specified therein; but no member or subscriber shall be entitled to have (except under the provisions of section III.) more than one work in his or her possession at the same time, or more than two volumes of the same work, unless such work shall be comprised in three volumes, when the whole may be taken out at once. Only one week will be allowed for the reading of any new book during the first two months after its introduction to the Library.

SECTION III.

Any member or subscriber may take a second work from the Library, and retain the same for the time specified therein, on payment to the Librarian of five cents per week for the time such work is detained; and subject to payment of fines in the same manner as for the first work taken out.
