## ST. LAWRENCE MARKET.

Owing to stormy weather the deliveries  
of farm produce at the St. Lawrence  
Market on Saturday were light—15 loads  
of hay, a few dressed hogs, several loads  
of mixed produce, and not a large deliv-  
ery on the market.

Hay—Fifteen loads sold at \$19 to \$21 per  
ton.  
Dressed Hogs—Prices firm at \$7.75 to  
\$8.25 per cwt.

Apples—Market easy at \$1.75 to \$3.50 per  
barrel, the latter price being paid for a  
choice barrel of "Spys," delivered, and  
the bulk going at \$2 to \$3 per barrel.  
Butter—Receipts of butter were larger  
than the demand, and prices declined, the  
bulk selling at 28c to 30c per lb. Some few  
farmers got 32c to 33c from special cus-  
tomers.

Eggs—Receipts were the largest in many  
weeks, the hens having got busy during  
the mild weather. Prices dropped from  
50c to 45c and 50c, and at the close of the  
market 40c was the ruling figure, as there  
were few city customers in comparison  
with recent markets.

Poultry—Receipts of poultry were light  
and prices were firmer, as follows: Tur-  
keys, 15c to 20c per lb.; geese, 15c to 18c  
per lb.; ducks, 15c to 18c per lb.; chickens,  
15c to 18c per lb. Chickens on the market  
later price being for stall-fed; fowl, 10c  
per lb.
