There was also read an Extract Minute of the Synod of New Brunswick, of date August 19, 1867, appointing the Rev. William Henderson, D.D., Minister of Newcastle, their Commissioner to attend this meeting of the Synod of Canada. The Clerk was instructed to add Dr. Henderson's name to the Roll.

ELECTION OF MODERATOR.

It was moved by Mr. Mann, seconded by Dr. Mathieson, and passed unanimously, That the Rev. Robert Dobie, Minister of Lindsay, be Moderator for the year; and he, being present, took the chair.

THANKS TO THE RETIRING MODERATOR.

On motion to that effect, the Moderator tendered to the Rev. Kenneth MacLennan, M.A., the thanks of the Synod for his very satisfactory conduct while in the Moderator's chair, and for the able and appropriate sermon preached by him this evening.

REPORT ON BUSINESS.

The Report of the Committee on Business was called for and read. The Synod agreed to follow the recommendations contained therein.

TRUSTEES OF QUEEN'S UNIVERSITY.

The Synod proceeded to the election of three Trustees of the University of Queen's College in room of the Rev. William Bain, the Rev. Dr. Mathieson, and the Rev. Archibald Walker, who retired according to the requirements of the Charter; when it was unanimously agreed to re-elect these members of the Board of Trustees of Queen's College.

REPORT OF THE TEMPORALITIES' BOARD.

The Synod next called for the Report and accompanying Financial Statements of the Board of Managers of the Temporalities' Fund, which were presented by the Secretary, Mr. James Croil.

The Synod adjourned to meet in this place to-morrow morning at half-past nine o'clock, of which public intimation was made, and this Diet was closed with prayer.
